Determine board (IHL) policy as to the time involved for this to happen.

Be bold enough to do something about it, and it shouldn't 24 months to do it.

Determine that we need to continue to work on articulation and transfer.

Look at what's worked and do the best we can to make it work here.

Dr. Bounds and Dr. Clark, after discussion with stakeholders, decide what our recommendations might be.
