These data are based on roughly 10,000 baccalaureate degrees awarded in AY2008.

Part-Time and Full-Time status are based on first term of enrollment.

Students taking 12 or more hours during their first term are full-time. Students taking less than 12 hours are part-time.

Of the more than 10,000 students earning a baccalaureate degree in AY2008, about one-third would qualify for the graduation rate cohort as full-time entering freshmen.

Students in 'Other Transfers' include all non-MSCC transfers. This includes transfers from other public and private 2-year and 4-year institutions.

Students of 'Other Origination' include students with other or unknown origination codes (readmitted, non-degree, etc.).

Definitions meet SREB criteria. Figures do not include UMMC.
