





Admissions by Academic Year

• The overall total number of nursing admissions has decreased slightly by -0.6 percent from AY 2017-18 to AY 2021-22. This decrease has been in the Baccalaureate (-8.8%) and Masters (-3.2%) programs. Doctoral programs experienced the only increase while Associate degree programs admission have remained steady.



• Nursing admissions by academic level have changed slightly from AY 2017-18 to AY 2021-22. Lower percentages of admissions are at the Baccalaureate and Masters Degree levels and there is a higher percentage of nursing admissions at the Doctoral level when comparing AY 2017-18 to AY 2021-22.



• Nursing enrollment decreased from fall 2018 to fall 2021 with a slight increase from fall 2021 to fall 2022. Enrollment decreased (-4.6%) from Fall 2018 to Fall 2022. Increases have been in the Masters (13.2%) and Doctoral (47.2%) programs. Decreases have been in the Associate (-5.0%) and Baccalaureate (-12.3%) programs.



• Nursing enrollment by academic level has changed from Fall 2018 to Fall 2022. Higher percentages of students are enrolling at the graduate level while fewer percentages of students are enrolling at the undergraduate level.







Associate Degree




Baccalaureate Degree




