




Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment











Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment








ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY TOTAL FTE AND TOTAL HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT


JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY TOTAL FTE AND TOTAL HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT










