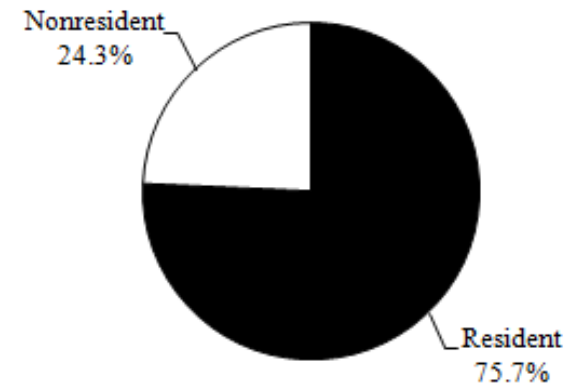
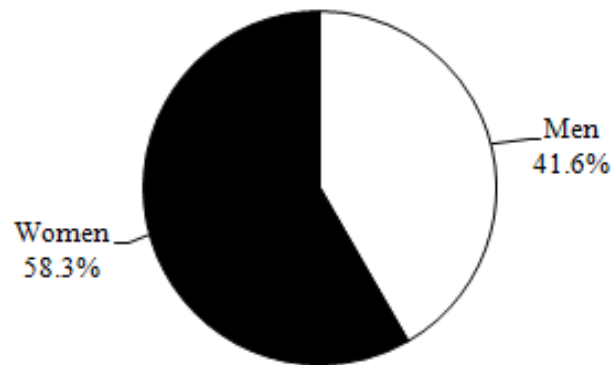
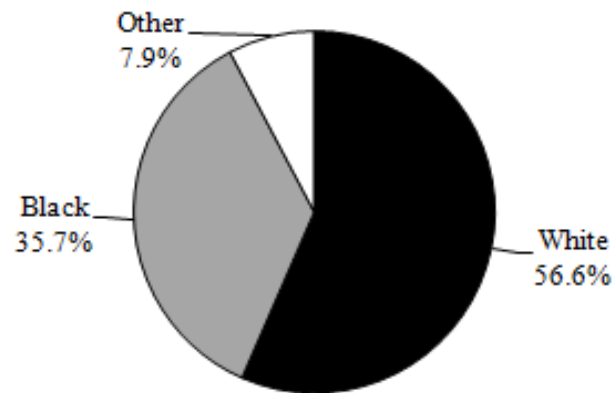
Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment
