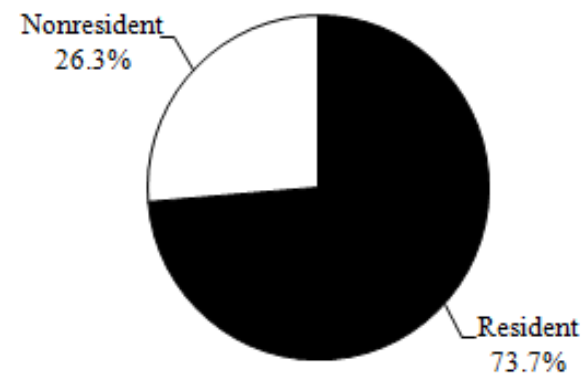
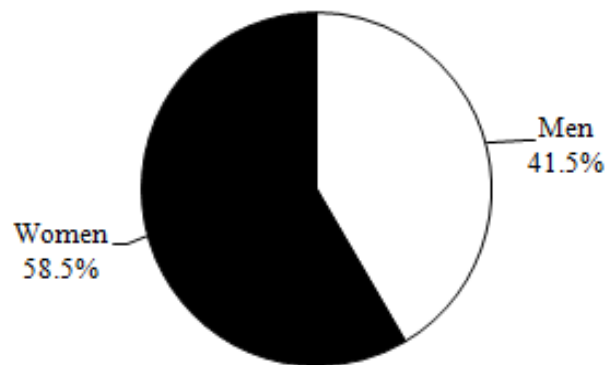
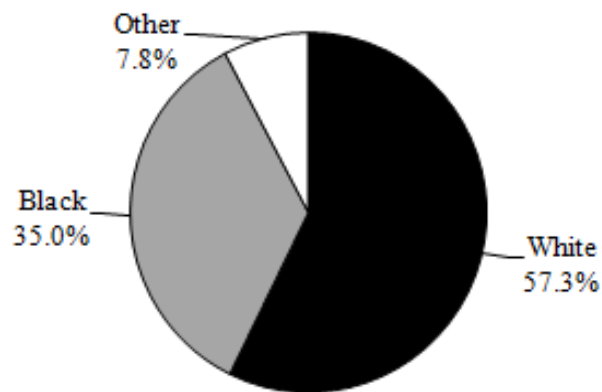
**Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment**
