The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools is the accrediting body for each of the public universities in Mississippi. In Fall 2021, 76,510 students enrolled in Mississippi's Universities, with an operating budget of \$4.88 billion. The system awarded 19,681 degrees in Academic Year 2020-21.
