Accident & Injury Prevention

A presentation about what "safety" means and five areas employees can focus on to meet a goal of being accident and injury free. Topics include attitude, behavior, conditions, communication, and learning from experiences. Target audience: anyone.

Accident / Injury Investigation

A presentation to help supervisors understand the need for accident and injury investigation as a prevention tool. Participants will be able to conduct a routine investigation to gather information used to prevent similar events from happening again. Focus is on who, what, when, where, why, how, and follow-up. Target audience: supervisory.

Slips, Trips & Falls

How do they happen and what can we do about it? Focuses on preventing potential cost, pain and suffering through attention to behaviors and conditions. Attendees will list actions that can be taken to reduce injuries from these causes. Target audience: Food Service, Custodial, Facilities, Grounds Maintenance.

Lifting Without Injury

How to lift and carry without getting hurt. A short presentation about basic spine design and proper body mechanics. Effects of torque and poor mechanics are illustrated. Target audience: anyone
