Academic Program Inventory

Definition of Terms

All the programs offered are listed under discipline categories. Accounting, for example, is found under the discipline category heading of Business Management and Administrative Services, chemistry under Physical Sciences, and music under Visual and Performing Arts.

The academic degrees and their descriptions are listed below:
