



• The overall total number of nursing admissions has decreased by -5.9 percent from AY 2019-20 to AY 2023-24. The decrease in the Baccalaureate (-16.7%) is representative of the decrease in postlicensure RN to BSN admissions which have seen a -38.9% decrease. Both Masters and Doctoral Programs have seen an increase in admissions, 29.6% & 24.1%, respectively.



• Nursing admissions by academic level have changed from AY 2019-20 to AY 2023-24. Lower percentages of admissions are at the Baccalaureate level and there is a higher percentage of nursing admissions at the Associate and Graduate level when comparing AY 2019-20 to AY 2023-24.





• The overall nursing enrollment continues to climb after the decline seen in the wake of the pandemic in 2021. All levels have seen an ovrall increase from Fall 2020 to Fall 2024 except for Baccalaureate.



• Nursing enrollment by academic level has changed from Fall 2020 to Fall 2024. Enrollment in Associate Degree programs has increased for the third year in a row. Overall enrollment in BSN programs has decreased primarily due to the decrease in RN to BSN enrollment. RN to BSN enrollment has decreased -28.2% over the past 5 years. Graduate programs have seen an increase.


